Draft Amended Community Services and Infrastructure Planning (Major Policy) 2021



Brimbank City Council, at its meeting on 17 August 2021, endorsed the draft amended Community Services and Infrastructure Planning (Major Policy) 2021 to proceed to Community Consultation:

The objectives of the updated draft Community Services and Infrastructure Planning (Major Policy) are:

- Providing Council with a consistent, responsive and evidence based approach to its planning and delivery of local, connected and sustainable community services and facilities.
- Developing and maintaining a network of quality, flexible and responsive community services and infrastructure that are designed and operated to meet the diverse needs of the communities of Brimbank.
- Applying an evidence-based planning approach to understand universal needs and demands as well as addressing specific areas of disadvantage and inequity.
- Building and supporting an inclusive, healthy and resilient community.

The changes to the updated draft Community Services and Infrastructure Planning (Major Policy) are:

- Addition of sport and recreation facilities in the policy scope to enable it to cover Councils Sports Facility Development Plan and Indoor Sports Facilities Feasibility Study.
- Minor updates and consolidation for Policy aims, objectives and definitions to cover added plans under the expanded scope.
- Updated guiding principles
- Inclusion of high level framework for assessing community infrastructure needs
- Updated related Council Policy and Strategy

The nature, purpose and rationale of the changes are:

Council has three community infrastructure related Plans of which only one is currently covered by the existing Community Services and Infrastructure Planning (Major Policy) due to plans being developed at different times. Changes have been made to the updated draft Major Policy so it now covers and provide strategic direction for all of Councils community infrastructure plans.
